

# CONCERT'S ROCK LEGENDS: SLADE, SMOKIE, SWEET

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

Only persons who hold a valid Concert's Rock Legends: Slade, Smokie, Sweet (hereinafter referred to as the Concert) ticket or wristband may be present in the Concert's territory. To cross the Concert's territory, a valid Concert ticket or wristband is required. Holders of valid tickets are entitled to be present in the Concert's territory during their opening hours subject to compliance with the Concert's rules.

By acquiring the Concert's ticket the visitor agrees to that during the Concert they can be photographed and filmed and that their image can be used for commercial and advertising purposes without the payment of consideration or the application of copyright.

In the Concert's venue, the visitors may be subjected to the search and personal checks, personal belongings and documents.

### CONCERT TICKETS AND WRISTBANDS

The Concert's ticket (hereinafter referred to as the Ticket) may be received at the entrance to its territory by producing valid Concert entry Ticket. Visitors of the VIP zone, as well as children under the age of 18 accompanied by their parents, will be issued wristbands.

The bar code of each Ticket is unique, and only the first visitor with the original bar code will be let into the Concert. It is strictly prohibited to copy and resell the ticket. The risk of simultaneous use of the Ticket original and duplicates is assumed by the buyer. The Organizer "Amber Way" SIA (hereinafter referred to as the Organizer) does not assume any liability for malicious use of the Ticket. It is prohibited to use the tickets in advertising and marketing campaigns, campaigns, lotteries, and competitions without prior written approval from the Organizer.

The presence in the Concert's territory is the confirmation that you agree to the Concert's rules that are placed in its territory. You can read them also on this site and near each entry.

### CONCERT TERRITORY RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Concert's visitors may enter in Concert's territory during the time when it is open for visitors. This information is available both on the Tickets and on the Ticketing websites.

The Concert's visitors may carry with them and use non-professional cameras (i.e. cameras without changeable lenses).

The Concert's visitors may enter the Concert's territory in accordance with the passing rules, with respective wristbands and vehicle passes.

In the Concert's territory it is prohibited to:

- use open fire (including candles, grills, oil lamps, torches etc.).
- use, sell and keep narcotic substances;
- carry in pets;
- carry out commercial activities in the Concert's territory without prior written approval from the Organizer.
- promote, offer or distribute any products and services without prior written approval from the Organizer;
- film and record sound without prior approval from the Organizer;
- for visitors under the age of 18, acquire alcohol and cigarettes;
- for visitors under the age of 16 (including), be in the Concert's territory without the supervision of the parents or lawful custodians.
- with one's behavior, threaten the safety and health of other visitors;

It is prohibited to carry into the Concert's territory:

- professional photo equipment (i.e. with changeable lenses) and video equipment without accreditation in accordance with the Concert's rules.
- any kinds of umbrellas;
- drugs;
- food products, alcoholic beverages and soft drinks;
- large-dimension items;
- other items that may threaten the convenience or safety of other visitors (e.g. weapons, explosives, knives, gas sprays, glass items etc.).

It's allowed to enter the Concert territory with special baby food, but before the entrance, it must be presented to the security staff.

The keeping of prohibited items and products outside the Concert's territory with the security guards or the Organizer is not provided.

The Concert's Organizer shall not assume any liability for:

- injuries suffered by the visitors during the Concert.
- damages to personal belongings or lost and stolen belongings – we kindly advise you not to carry in and leave expensive and valuable items in the Concert's territory.
- the quality of the food, drinks and other goods or services sold and provided in the Concert's territory – full liability for it is assumed by the respective service provider.
- the Organizer do not assume responsibility for unused tickets, and they will not be refunded.
- any actions taken by state authorities or institutions during the Concert and in its territory.

The Concert Organizer has the right to:

- without prior notice, change the Concert's program and the performance times of the artists.
- not let in or evict from the Concert's territory any visitors whose behavior might hinder the due course of the Concert and/or threaten the safety of other visitors.
- the Organizer shall be entitled not to sell alcoholic beverages to persons that are under the overdose of alcohol and may threaten themselves or other visitors of the Concert.

All the persons in the Concert's territory are obliged to adhere to any instructions and orders from the Organizer related to the course of the Concert and the keeping of order, including those not covered by these Rules but communicated during the Concert. If the Concert's rules or any instructions and orders from the Organizer are not adhered to, the Organizer will be entitled to expel the person from the Concert's territory.

The International Popular Music Festival **NOSTALGIA FEST '24**, which was supposed to take place on July 5-7, 2024 at the Grand Stage in Mezaparks, has been **CANCELED** and will not be held at the specified place and time.

Instead of the planned International Popular Music Festival **NOSTALGIA FEST '24**, a **“Rock Legends: Slade, Smokie, Sweet”** concert will be held at Wondersala on July 5, 2024.

Those who purchased tickets for both days of the festival will be given access to the VIP zone Wopndersala with a standing bar.
